The Faculty of Philosophy of the Dominican University College invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor to commence August 1st, 2018. The appointment is for one year, with the possibility of renewal for up to two additional years, subject to funding and performance review.

Area of Specialization: History of Philosophy (Medieval Philosophy and Late Medieval Philosophy)

Areas of Competence: Metaphysics, Ethics, Rationalism, Modern Empiricism, Philosophy of Education and Political Philosophy

The successful candidate must hold a Ph.D. in Philosophy by the date of appointment, or shortly thereafter, and have research expertise in one or both areas of specialization noted above, demonstrated accomplishments in scholarship (evidenced by high-quality publications and significant conference participation), and an excellent record of teaching at the undergraduate level. Teaching competence in both English and French and in both areas listed is a requirement. The successful candidate will be expected to maintain an active program of research and teaching, and to undertake service duties as assigned by the Dean of the Faculty. The teaching load will be five 3-credit courses per year.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
